



4-H Project Fair and Portfolio Rules



Junior Demonstrations (5th)

- Individual 4-H demonstrations (no team demos allowed).
- Time limit: 3-5 minutes
- TWO demonstrations PER PROJECT per county are allowed.
- No 4-H member should be involved in more than one demonstration on this day.
- Demonstrations should relate in some way to appropriate 4-H project material.
- 4-Hers are responsible for bringing their own easel.

Junior High Interactive Exhibits (6th - 8th)

- Individual 4-H exhibits only (no team exhibits allowed)
- Time limits: 4-Her's explanation (1-2 minutes)
Judge's questions (2-3 minutes)
- THREE interactive exhibits PER PROJECT per county are allowed.
- 4-Hers may enter only ONE exhibit with this exception: 4-Hers may enter one 4-H project exhibit plus a citizenship or leadership project exhibit.
- Each 4-Her will be given half of a six foot table for displaying their exhibit.
- Free standing exhibit boards or posters should be used.
- Space from the table to the floor may be used.
- Items may be displayed on the table.
- The exhibit should have a title and include the word 4-H or the 4-H clover somewhere on the exhibit.
- The exhibit needs to relate to the project material for that level.

Project Portfolios (6th - 8th)

- 4-Hers may enter only ONE portfolio with this exception: 4-Hers may enter one 4-H project portfolio plus a citizenship or leadership project portfolio.
- Portfolios will be judged on the Regional Level only
- Will not be used to determine Premiere Exhibitor
- Awards will be distributed at sub-regional contests

Special Note:

There will no longer be a winning rule. 4-H members may participate every year in interactive exhibits and portfolios.
